SOUTHWEST LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT **Cafeteria Charge Policies**

Elementary Schools

Charges for meals or milk are permitted for students who occasionally forget or misplace their money. We ask that charges be repaid the following school day. Charge notices will be sent home weekly. Students who do not repay charges on the following school day will be allowed a MAXIMUM of 3 charges (or the dollar equivalent of 3 lunches). After the 3rd charge, a parent will be notified by a phone call. Any student who has accumulated 3 charges and is sent to school with no money or packed lunch will be asked to call their parent to bring a lunch. If no lunch is provided by the parent, we will offer peanut butter, crackers, and a milk to the student and will charge the price of a milk (\$.50) to the student's cafeteria account.

Junior School

Charges for a meal or milk are permitted for students who occasionally forget or misplace money. Only a regular complete lunch or a milk can be charged, no ala carte. Charges must be repaid the following school day. No further charges will be permitted until all existing charges have been paid. If no lunch or money is sent in, the student will be asked to call their parent to bring in money or lunch. If the parent does not provide a lunch or if the student declines to call parent, we will offer peanut butter, crackers, and a milk to the student and charge the price of a milk (\$.50) to the student's account. Charge notices will be sent home monthly.

High School

No charges are permitted. Any student who is sent to school without money for lunch or a packed lunch, will be offered to make a call to the parent to bring them money or a lunch. If the parent does not provide for lunch then the student will be offered peanut butter, crackers, and a milk and be charged for the price of milk (\$.50).
