Dear AUSD Families,

Welcome to the 2023-2024 school year! AUSD's Food and Nutrition Services Department (FANS) has spent this summer preparing for your return and look forward to providing well-prepared, good-tasting food for your students.

This year, FANS pledges to continue to offer meals that provide a variety of protein choices and grains, fresh fruits and vegetables, and milk and that are as tasty as possible, so students get the nutrition they need to succeed at school. Those meals will also meet the federal government's strict nutrition standards, including:



Age-appropriate calorie limits.

- Larger servings of vegetables and fruits (students must take at least one serving of produce)
- A wider variety of vegetables, including dark green and red/orange veggies, as well as legumes.
- Fat-free or 1% milk (flavored milk must be fat-free); and
- More whole grains and less sodium

Commencing in SY 2022–23, Education Code (EC) 49501.5 requires public school districts, county offices of education, and charter schools serving students in grades TK–12 to provide two meals free of charge (breakfast and lunch) during each school day to students requesting a meal, regardless of their free or reduced-price meal eligibility. Meals, at this point, is here to stay. It will continue in the 2023/24 school year. Pricing only applies to students getting a second breakfast and/or lunch.
