## Free/Reduced Meal Benefits

Interested in applying for Free/Reduced Meal benefits? Apply for school meal benefits online after July 31, 2023. Go to [LINQconnect.com](https://LINQconnect.com) to fill out an application. Only one application per household is required. Remember, if you have students that were approved for meal benefits during the 22-23 school year, they will remain on the previous year's status for the first 30 days of school.

We are excited to announce 8 out of 14 schools in YCS will be participating in Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) this year. CEP is a provision that allows schools in low income areas to offer breakfast and lunch meals at no cost to all students at eligible schools. Students enrolled in a CEP school for the 23-24 school year do not need to complete a free/reduced meal application. If you have multiple students who attend different schools, you must still complete an application and include all students in the household.
